## Overview

**Program Focus:** Equips students for vocational ministry in a variety of contexts. Students increase their understanding of the Bible and develop practical skills for various church leadership roles. Additionally, students deepen their theological roots, strengthen their relationship with God, and develop their ministry gifts.

**Possible Careers:** Senior/Youth/Worship Pastor/Men’s and Women’s Ministry/specialty ministries.

## Program

**Length:** 120 Units organized into five-week classes

**Courses:** Students may transfer in at any time with General Education and General Elective units. The Major Core class units are a total of 45 units. Free evaluation is available to see if previous units fulfill transfer requirements.

**Cost** If the program is taken completely with Hope:

<b>Per unit:</b> General Education/General Elective units are \$250.00/unit X 72 units = \$18,000.00
Major Core Units are \$450.00/unit X 48 units = <u>\$21,600.00</u>
Total                    \$39,600.00
