Program Focus: Students will gain a critical base of knowledge and skills for entrance into teaching, counseling, and other helping professions. Students will study the life-span of human development, learning theories, research methods, teaching strategies, and more.

Program

Length: 120 units organized into five-week classes

Courses: Students may transfer in at any time with General Education and General Elective units. The Major Core class units are a total of 45 units. Free evaluation is available to see if previous units fulfill transfer requirements.

Cost If the program is taken completely with Hope:

Per unit: General Education/General Elective units are \$250.00/unit X 74 units = \$18,500.00
Major Core units are \$450.00/unit X 46 units = \$20,700.00
Total \$39,200.00
