## Program

**Length:** 36 Units - The program consists of three semesters of fifteen weeks each. Courses are five weeks in length and run consecutively.

**Courses:** Students may need to complete the following prerequisites: Principles of Economics, Accounting and Finance. There are four concentrations:

- Marketing Management
- Non-Profit Management
- International Development
- General Management

**Cost Per Unit:** Graduate units are \$595.00/unit X 36 units = \$21,420.00

Prerequisites are \$297.50/unit
