University Center Moves to Everett Community College Campus

On March 24, 2009 the University Center of North Puget Sound moved its offices and classes to the newly constructed Gray Wolf Hall on the campus of Everett Community College. EvCC provides leadership and management for the Center. Gray Wolf Hall will also be home to community college classes in the humanities, social sciences and communications. The building is located immediately south of EvCC's Parks Student Union and Jackson Center.

Gray Wolf Hall is the second of four new academic buildings recently constructed or planned for EvCC. The 77,000 square foot "green" building meets University Center's need for additional classroom space for bachelor and graduate degree programs offered by six partner universities and colleges. Gray Wolf Hall also features state of the art technology to support distance and online coursework. "Everett Community College is undergoing major changes now that will shape the college's future for decades to come. Gray Wolf Hall is part of that transformation," said EvCC President David Beyer. "Bringing the University Center to campus will make it even more convenient for students to pursue bachelor's and master's degrees from our university partners."
